Example 2

Cool Season Grasses (CP1) and Native Grasses (CP2)

A Pennsylvania Sportsman Club would like to develop habitat for pheasants and other wildlife. They also want to prevent sediment from entering an adjacent cold water trout stream.

- 25 acres of cool season grasses (CP1) and 60 acres of mixed native grasses (CP2) will be established.
- Total of 85 acres will be enrolled in CREP
- The average soil rental rate (SRR) for the offered land is \$50.00 per acre.
- The contract will cover 15 years.
- Total Cost to establish the conservation practices is \$75/acre.

Payment to Establish Conservation Practice: 100% of

eligible cost for establishing practices. 85 acres X \$75 = \$6,375 One Time
